

## EHSC SCHOOLING MINI TRIALS

### General Rules

1. Please read the rulebook and update which can be found on the mini trial website, [www.minitrialassoc.org](http://www.minitrialassoc.org)
2. Entry concerns need to be addressed to the Secretary. All other questions can be addressed to the Organizer.
3. If a rider is eliminated in either dressage or stadium, he/she must ask for permission from the chief judge to continue cross country.
4. Cross Country courses will be open for schooling from 12 noon to 5 pm on Saturday, August 3, 2019. SCHOOLING WILL STOP PROMPTLY AT 5PM. NO EXCEPTIONS. Schooling may be available by appointment during the week by calling the Organizer. Schooling will be weather permitting. It may be limited due to footing. All schooling must be paid in advance. Riders must check in with Secretary to verify release forms are signed, fees paid, and to receive a number prior to entering the XC course. Numbers must be worn while schooling. All riders must be accompanied by an adult/ground person with a radio or cell phone. Protective vests and ASTM/SEI helmets are required. Medical armband recommended.
5. Only the competitor may ride (warm-up) his/her horse.
6. Late entries may be accepted after the closing date only if space is available, and a \$20 late fee must accompany the entry form. If there is awaiting list, entries will be accepted in the order they were received.
7. No refunds for entries accepted after the closing date. Refunds before the closing date may be granted. Any changes to the entry after the closing date will incur a \$10 change fee.
8. Negative Coggins test required for ALL out of state horses **and must accompany the entry form.**
